

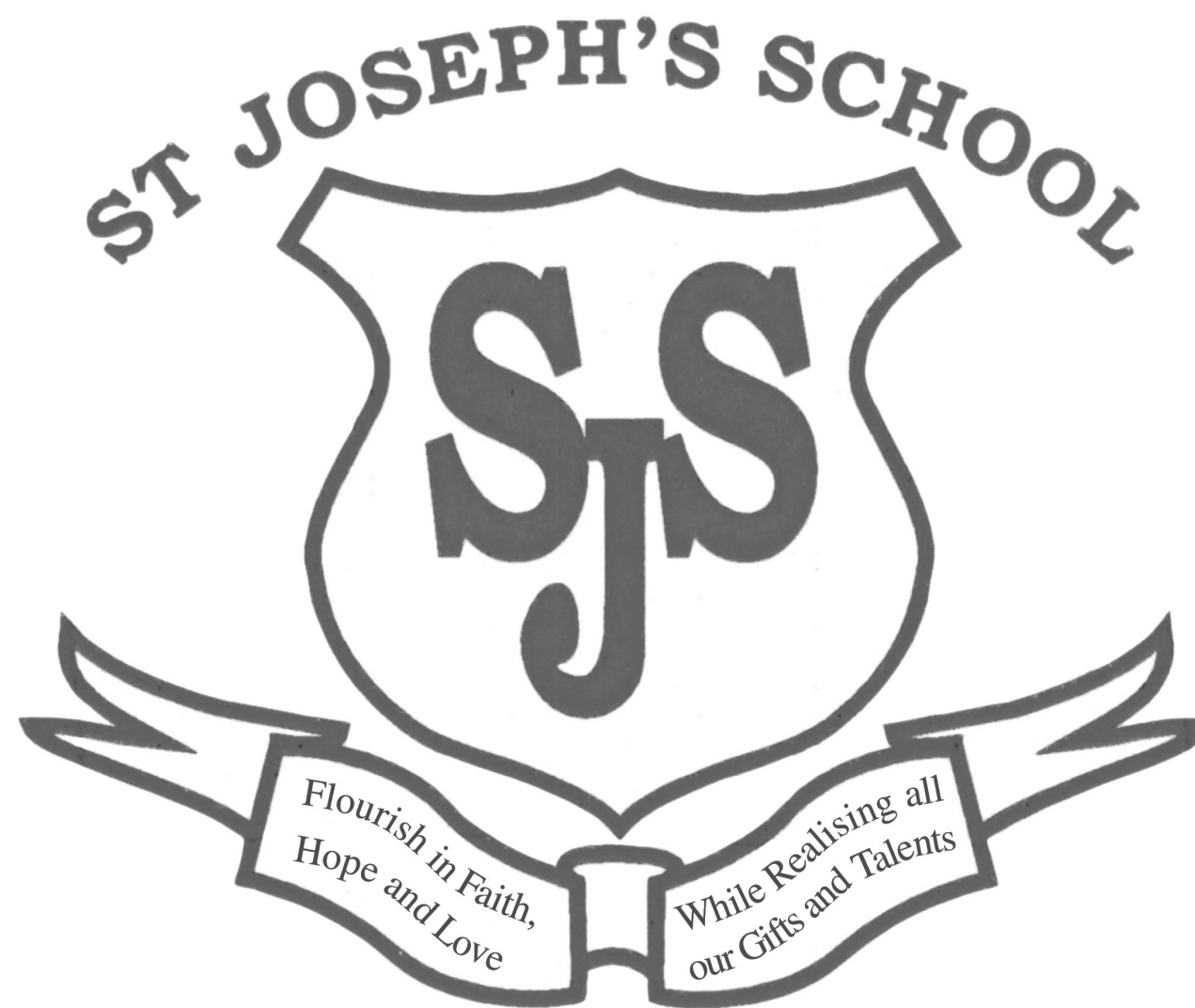
Show Day Times and Activities
