Criteria:

- Images and background is relevant to the message.
- No unnecessary content.
- Message is clear and obvious.
- Appropriate colours and patterns used to suit message.

Creative writing—Five senses

Criteria:

- Use of one or more of the five senses effectively.
- Use of descriptive language; adjectives, adverbs, vivid verbs.
- Use of imagery / figurative speech.
- Correct spelling and punctuation.

Criteria:

- Interesting shape bowl.
- Creative patterns and impressions.
- Colours used effectively.

Criteria:

- Design 'pops up' when opened.
- Visually appealing design.

Criteria:

- 3D display must be able to fit on an A4 card.
